

Requirements for B. S. in Criminal Justice – Major Code 3-1031

Criminal Justice CORE courses – must be completed with grade of C or above 30 units Required

Note: You must have completed **60** units in order to enroll in *upper division CORE courses*.

Notes on Substitutions for CORE classes:

- You may substitute similar courses completed at another college or university with permission of advisor.
- You may **NOT** substitute *lower division* courses for upper division courses.
- If you have completed a statistics course that goes through *t* and *chi square* with a grade of **C** or above you may substitute a 3-unit upper division CRIM course for CRIM 303 (in addition to 12 units required below).
- Students who are working in the criminal justice system may substitute CRIM 490 Independent Study (30 page library research paper) for CRIM 495 Internship.

- You may NOT substitute *lower division* courses for upper division courses.
