

Reasons why you may be having difficulty registering

If you cannot register at all:

- 1) you may be attempting to register ahead of your assigned registration time
- 2) you may still be a pre-major with more than sixty units. To register you need to declare a major. See a Peer Advisor for the Psychology major requirements and temporary alternative major suggestions if you do not yet qualify.

If you are having trouble registering for 400 level psychology classes:

- 1) you need to be a psychology major
- 2) you need to have completed or be taking Psy 301
- 3) you need to have met ALL of the prerequisites for the course(s). For instance Psy 457 requires that you have senior standing. Other 400 level courses have specific 300 or 400 level courses as prerequisites. For instance, Psy 407 requires that you have completed Psy 370, 373, and 475. Check the current catalog either online or via the hard copy.

If you are having trouble registering for psychology courses designated as GE classes such as Psy 300I, 351, 356, 370, 375I:

- 1) you may not have fulfilled the prerequisite GE requirements. If you believe you have, then check with Enrollment Services. The psychology department cannot clear you for your GE requirements.
- 2) You may not have enough units. Freshmen cannot register in upper division courses.

If you are having trouble registering for psychology courses with lower division prerequisites such as 310, 314, 331, 332, 333, etc.:

- 1) the computer may not be recognizing your lower division courses because you took them at another college or university and they have not yet been added to the database in the new "MyCSULB" system. If that is your problem, fill out the IVR clearance form in the peer advising office. You must attach documentation to verify that you have taken the course (or courses).
- 2) there may be a computer glitch (sorry, we have no better explanation). For instance some students who are currently enrolled in the listed prerequisites or who took them previously at CSULB have been unable to register for classes that are open. If that is your problem, fill out the IVR clearance form and indicate that the course is in progress or which semester you passed it.

If you are having trouble registering for psychology courses with only Psy 100 as a prerequisite and they are not GE classes, you should check with Enrollment Services.
