

How to Use NJ Communicator

What is NJStar Communicator? NJStar Communicator is a program which allows you to input Chinese, Japanese and Korean texts. You can use the program together with notepad, wordpad, Netscape mail, Eudora etc.

Activate it: Double click on the NJStar Communicator icon. The program will be activated and you will see a short bar on the upper right corner of the screen with a red character



With NJStar Communicator on, you can view Chinese, Japanese or Korean online.

Move your cursor to touch the bar. The bar will display 6 icons:

Select codes:



Click on the flag icon to select a proper code. For Chinese, it is suggested to select "Chinese Big5 Traditional" if you want to use traditional characters. For simplified characters, it is suggested to select "Chinese GB simplified". With the correct selection of codes, Chinese characters will be displayed.

Or, you can just select Chinese Auto Traditional.

To view Japanese or Korean, select the appropriate codes respectively.




Input Chinese characters:




Click on the keyboard icon. Then click on Chinese input. An input bar will appear at the bottom of the screen. Click on Chinese Input, you will see an input bar appearing at the bottom of the screen.

. To type Japanese or Korean select Japanese Input or Korean Input.

Typing Chinese and English

When you see  on the left end of the input bar, it means that you can type Chinese.  Hold the control key and press space bar, the input mode will be changed to  and you can type English. Hold the control key and press space bar again to toggle back to Chinese mode.

Type Chinese words in Pinyin. You will see the characters on the input bar.

 If the word is the one you need, press space bar and this word will enter the window of your application (word pad, notepad or email editing windows).

If there are several words, press the number before the word and select it.
