Advisory Committee on Enrollment Management

Charge

The Advisory Committee on Enrollment Management is a joint faculty and administrative committee charged with the responsibility for advising the President on all matters pertaining to the management of the University's student enrollment. Such matters include, but are not limited to, the determination size and rate of growth of student enrollment, the various policy devices fo controlling that size and rate of growth, and the development of procedures' unicating the University's enrollment management plans to affected encies within and without the University. The Committee is also charge with the responsibility for ensuring broad and meaningful consultation on management matters within the University community and with our e hal constituencies.

The Committee shall provide an annual reproposition its activities to the Academic Senate in April of each academic year.
