- 7.2 Proposed revision of PS 19-08, Policy on General Education (AS-1137-20/CEPC) -- SECOND READING
 - Second reading started from the beginning of the policy but amendments to policy began on Line 152 Section 2.4. Amended by D. Paskin, moved and seconded. Add text "Upper division GE courses... when they need them" and "In exceptional cases only... the Explorations stage" to replace Lines 157-166.
 Voting Results: Yes=43, No=15. Amendment Passes.
 - Line 313-316, Section 3.2.3.1 amended by J. Pandya, moved and seconded. Add language "Students must complete nine units... in Subarea C3" Discussion ensues. Voting Results: Yes=45, No=11. Amendment **Passes**.

 Line 324 Section 3.2.3.1 amended by J. Pandya, moved and seconded. Add language "US History courses... fulfill their Area D requirements (double-count)." Discussion ensues.

End at this point. Will resume at this line (Line 324) at next AS meeting.

 - N. Schürer moved to waive first reading, B. Jersky seconded this. No objections to waiving of first reading.
 - Vote on resolution as a whole, moved and seconded.
 Voting Results: Yes=58, No=2. Resolution passes.
