### 6. SPECIAL ORDERS

- 6.1 Report from CSULB President Jane Conoley, TIME CERTAIN 2:10 PM
  - JC reports on the California State University and the University of California announced our joint intent to require students, faculty, and staff to possess proof of a COVID-19 vaccination as a condition for participating in on-campus instruction and/or co-curricular activities or accessing campus facilities.
    - This requirement will become effective as early as this fall, if and when one or more of the available vaccines receives full approval by the Food and Drug Administration. (Vaccines currently carry emergency authorization for their use.)
    - The announcement in full appears below. "We know there will be questions around this new requirement, which we as a campus and as a system will seek to address in greater detail in the weeks to come. I believe that this is an important part of safely resuming a full university life back on campus and our progression toward the next normal. We look forward to sharing more information with you."
  - CSULB Police Advisory Committee has recently been formed. JC will be meeting with them soon.
  - Budget news is still quite optimistic, waiting for May revise at this point.
- 6.2 Report from CFA Co-President Deborah Hamm
  - DH reports on the many moving parts in the vaccine situation. COVID leave currently being negotiated with the CO. Rallies on May day regarding the Union.
  - MA asked about a GSI, which is currently being discussed. CFA cannot discuss this at this time. Wait until July 1.

#### 7. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- 7.1 Open GE discussions, new ideas
  - Moved and seconded. P. Shankar, M. Aliasgari, and P. Hung explains a new GE idea regarding PS 19-08 Section 3.2.4 Area D, Social Sciences. Students may take a D3 course in lower division and take either D1 or D2 in upper division and vice versa. This provides flexibility to the programs/colleges.
  - The proposed language is listed below. "3.2.4.1 Distribution- Students must complete six units at the lower-division level and three units at the upperdivision level in Area D, Social Sciences. As a part of Area D, students must complete:
    - (1) one approved course at either lower-division or upper-division in US History that fulfills the requirements articulated in Title 5, Section 40404
    - (2) one approved course at either lower-division or upper-division in Constitution and American ideals that fulfills the requirements articulated in Title 5, Section 40404.

Area D has the following subareas: Subarea D1: Approved lower-division courses in US History. Subarea D2: Approved lower-division courses in Constitution and American Ideals. Subarea D3: Approved lower-division courses in Social Sciences and Citizenship. Subarea D-UD: Approved upper-division courses in Area D."

- Discussion of the idea ensues. Motion to table this discussion and reviewing GE Policy for 2 weeks. Moved and seconded. Vote on motion: Yes=45, No= 7.
   Tabling GE discussion and reviewing GE policy at this point.
- 7.2 Proposed revision of PS 19-08, Policy on General Education (AS-1137-20/CEPC)-SECOND READING

  - Moved and seconded. D. Paskin again explains the changes made by CEPC in 2019. DP explained that Programs were not mentioned in the old policy so added into the revisions of this policy.
  - NS suggests a chart to compare the original and revised text. Moves to second reading at next AS meeting.
