As the Administrative liaison to the Academic Integrity Committee (AIC), I offer this summary of our activities for the 2021-22 Academic Year.

The AIC reviewed forty-six (46) cases in fall semester, and eleven (11) cases in spring semester. The committee's opinion was in support of the faculty in fifty-four (54) cases, and in support of the student in two (2) cases. There was one (1) case in which the student requested to withdraw and not move forward with the committee's review.
