To teach in Los Angeles Unified, you must hold a bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited college or university

☐ **BASIC SKILLS**

Teachers must meet the Basic Skills requirement through the CBEST exam or equivalent

☐ **SUBJECT  
MATTER**

Teachers must meet the Subject Matter requirement for their credential.

☐ **REFERENCES**

Teachers must have a reference from their direct supervisor in their last school-based or child-centered employment

☐ **APPLICATION**
