

## HOW TO ACCESS CANVAS LAYOUTS (SIMILAR TO BEACHBOARD TEMPLATES)

- 1. Sign into your <u>CSULB Single Sign-on (SSO) portal</u>.
- 2. Click on the BeachBoard Canvas chiclet



3. On the BeachBoard and Canvas Login page, click on the Canvas Login link or image.




- 4. From your <u>Canvas Dashboard</u>, select and enter the course you will importing the layout to. Confirm that it is ready for content to be imported.
- 5. On the left-hand global navigation menu, click the Commons icon:



6. Here in the Commons, you'll find all kinds of shared items, such as videos, files, and entire courses. You may see the three Academic Technology Services (ATS) Online Course Layouts at the top:






- a. If the ATS Layouts do not appear at the top, you can filter.
- b. Or search using keywords in the title.
- 7. Click on the title of the desired template, either Quick Start Course, Foundational Course, or Advanced Design Course Layout. You will get to a Preview page, which lists the content of the course layout:


