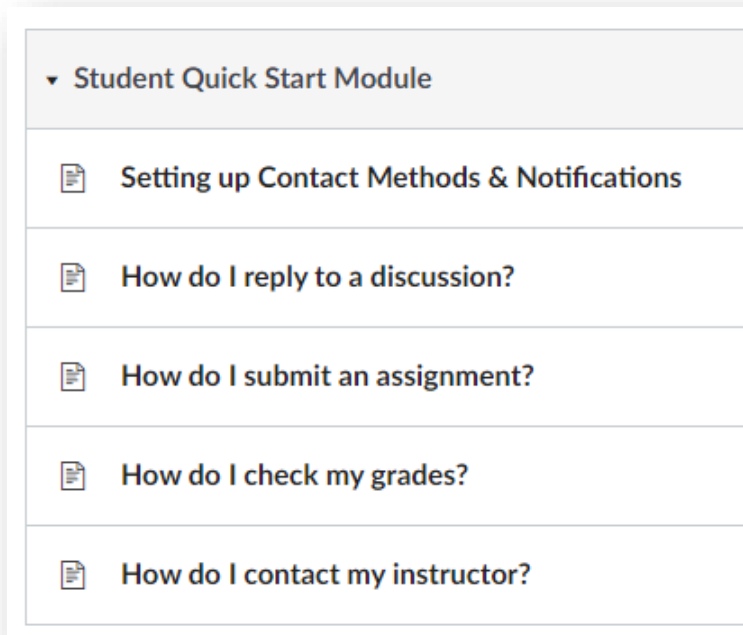




WHAT IS THE CANVAS STUDENT QUICK START MODULE?

This overview goes over the content of the Student Quickstart Module. This module is placed in every Canvas course by default as a starting point for students new to Canvas. As an instructor, you may add to, modify, unpublish/publish, or even delete it, just like any other content in your course. These are the components of the Quickstart Module:



Setting Up Contact Methods & Notifications

This item provides valuable information for students on how to set up notifications for their preferred contact methods. For example, an announcement or a message in their Canvas inbox could trigger an email sent to their preferred contact. As a result, they can receive a text or email when something noteworthy happens in your course.

How To Reply to A Discussion

This item provides a concise set of directions on replying to posts. The following setting is mentioned for the students' benefit and a setting you may choose to use: "replies are only visible to those who have posted at least one reply."

How To Contact Your Instructor

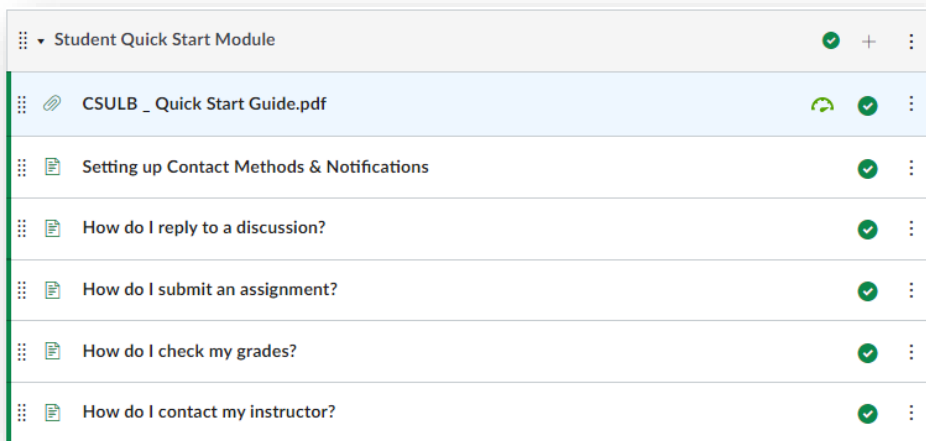
Students and instructors alike may want to take advantage of the messaging system within Canvas. This page goes over how to send messages to and from the Canvas inbox.

VIEW THE STUDENT QUICK START MODULE:

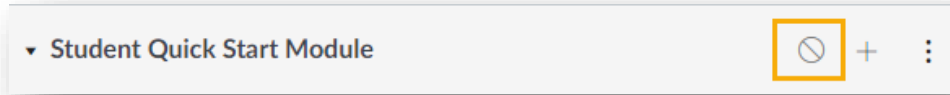
1. From your Canvas Dashboard, open your course.
2. From the left-hand menu, select **Modules**.
3. Select any of the page links within the *Student Quick Start Module* to view the content:





HIDING AND REMOVING THE STUDENT QUICK START MODULE (2 OPTIONS):

- A. Select the **green checkmark** next to the module title so that the check is replaced with a no-symbol. This action is called *un-publishing*, and it makes the module invisible to students:
