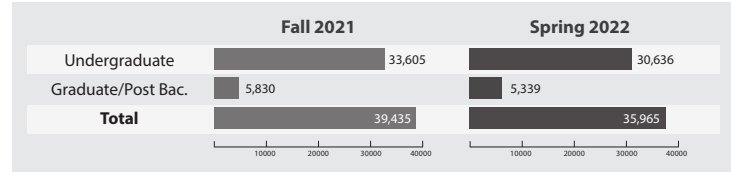

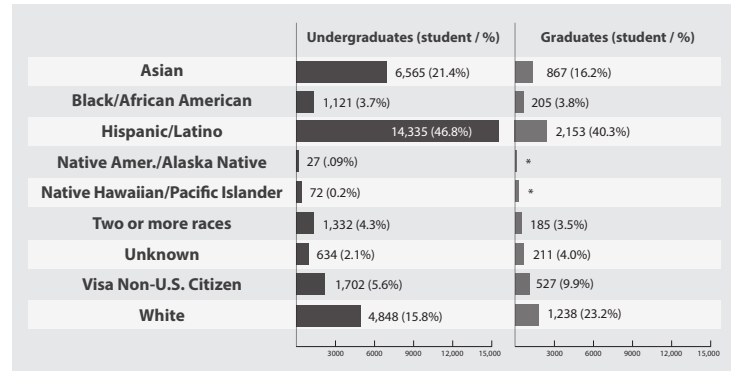

As part of our commitment to sustainability, CSULB has the largest solar power system on a CSU campus, providing 4.5 megawatts of energy from solar panels.

CSULB's Division I athletic teams surpassed the NCAA's Academic Progress Rate minimum score. The university has exceeded the minimum score for 15 consecutive years.
