Self-Guided Tour Guidelines

If this is for a group, we recommend the size be limited to 100 students per tour.

Students

- Students must respect CSULB property.
- Students must remain with chaperones throughout the duration of the tour.
- Students should not interrupt or interfere with normal campus activities.

Chaperones

- A chaperone ratio of 1 adult to 12 minors is recommended. We recommend that larger groups be split into subgroups and request at least one chaperone accompanies each subgroup.
- Supervision of students will be your responsibility throughout the duration of the tour.

Lunch

• There are many dining options at CSULB. Contact the bookstore at (562) 985-5093 for food service assistance. Accommodations for large groups (50+) may not be possible without advanced notice. *Make arrangements at least two weeks prior to your tour.*

Parking Information

- For same day visits, park in a General Lot. *Virtual parking permits are required to park on campus*. For additional parking information, stop by the Visitor Information Center.
- For bus parking arrangements, contact the Parking & Transportation Services Office at (562) 985-4146 at least two weeks prior to your visit.

University Student Union

• Visiting students must follow the University Student Union (USU) Guidelines in the following areas: arcade, bowling, pool and billiards. For more information, contact the USU Info Center at (562) 985-4834. Note that visitors of the University Student Union (USU) must be 18 and over, unless they are accompanied by chaperones.

Specialized Tours

• If you are interested in visiting the University Art Museum, the Japanese Garden, or the Student Recreation & Wellness Center, contact their offices at least two weeks prior to your visit. A nominal fee may be required for admission.
