



### **What If There Is A Face Covering Issue During Class?**

1. Faculty should first offer masks to students without an appropriate face covering (face coverings will be provided to you for classroom distribution).
2. Students who refuse to put on a face covering or to properly wear one must be told to leave and are not allowed to return without a face covering.
  - a. If the student leaves voluntarily, faculty should encourage student to see their major or academic advisor to explore suitable online course alternatives; written referral to Office of Student Conduct and Ethical Development is encouraged for consistency.
  - b. If the student refuses to leave, the faculty member may dismiss the class for the day and should refer the non-compliant student to the Office of Student Conduct and Ethical Development using the online reporting [form](#).
