Division of Information Technology Report

The Division of Information Technology (DoIT) is CSU Long Beach's enterprise technology organization and is responsible for providing high-quality, reliable, and secure information and technology services that facilitate student success and enable faculty and staff to do the best they can do.

- Continuing to expand on faith-based and City partnerships to donate used serviceable computers to community centers to bridge the digital divide. In addition to donating recycled computers to a local church, DoIT is working with a local charity organization (Human IT) recommended by the City of Long Beach's **Technology and Innovation Department** to donate our recycled computing equipment to needy families in Long Beach—currently, 85 recycled desktop computers, 27 laptop computers, and 13 monitors to deliver to Human IT.
- As of February 12, partnering with the Division of Student Affairs, DoIT has delivered 1,704 laptop computers and 3,008 Internet hotspots to needy CSULB students. With CARES II funds, DoIT will continue to offer/loan free-loan laptop computers and hotspots to needy students to help address the digital divide gap among CSULB students.
- All DoIT management team members actively participated in diversity training and are more aware of the need to address equity and diversity needs within the DoIT, including staff recruitment and interaction among DoIT staff and the campus community.
