- 4. <u>Blended Programs</u> (see link for implementation guide)
 - a. Blended programs combine existing bachelor's degree and master's degree
 - b. CSULB is not doing very well at recruiting our students into our own grad programs; this is one way to improve recruitment from our own undergrads
 - No requirement to apply for the grad program if selected into a blended program. Programs develop their own application process and deadline. Application may but does not have to mirror CSA process. ARS used to process change to Master's level.

 - i. Jody: programs can make this choice. Consider equity gap if requiring 3.0. Once switched to grad status, then would be on warning if < 3.0.
 - e. Norbert: expresses concern for blended programs, a bachelors degree + masters degree could be awarded with 120 + 30 12 units, which may not result in a high quality education and is not likely to close equity gap.
