VI. MMUF Writing Sample/Essay

- The MMUF Essay should be submitted as an attached document, please write an essay of 3-4 pages (typed in Times New Roman, 12 pt. font, double spaced with 1 inch margins), clearly describing the following all three segments:

- A) Your academic research interests and possible career plans;
- B) How the MMUF program and Dr. Mays' ideals ([a brief biography of Dr. Mays is on the MMUF website](#)) might be integral to your academic goals; and
- C) What you hope to achieve in the program.

VII. Academic Writing Sample

- Please provide an academic writing sample, approximately 5-10 pages in length (e.g. paper submitted for a course, research paper, publication, etc.). The writing sample should reflect the student's writing and analytical skills. While applicants are not required to submit a humanities-related writing sample, it is encouraged.

VIII. References

Signed confidential letters of recommendation printed on official letterhead from two (2) faculty must be emailed directly to aa-mmuf@csulb.edu on or before the deadline. The deadline is March 8, 2023 by 11:59PM PST.

IX. Confirm permission for committee to retrieve academic transcripts.

X. Submit Current Resume

- Must include extracurricular activities and honors/awards

XI. Interviews will be held March 9, 10, and 11 (tentatively)

- Applicants who are invited to interview **MUST** be available to attend on the scheduled interview days, no exceptions will be granted. Otherwise, applicant will forfeit any opportunity to proceed in the selection process.
