## Discussion and changes made following discussion with the PARC:

- The committee read through the report and had no comments and found it to be accurate.
- Drs. Vargas and Claver thank the reviewers for their support and time in this process, and found it a thoughtful review. The program has already started to implement some of the recommended changes.
- Nielan Barnes: Under the Concerns section, there were concerns regarding Headcount, under Recommendation #5, suggests that the recommendation be changed to the following:
  - 5. Explore issues related to admission rates and headcount, average time to degree, graduation rates and degrees awarded in order to mitigate any barriers to graduation. Improve the timely completion of the thesis or directed project to shorten the time-to-degree by 1) having students take the GERN 696 (Research Methods) earlier and/or 2) tying directed projects with the internship.
- Nielan also recommends adding "as resources permit" at the end of Recommendation #2.

- Dr. Claver: it was difficult to get the necessary data, and hopes there is/will be a better way to get data to explore trends.
- Adam Kahn notes that the PARC dashboards have been updated to make them a bit more user-friendly.
- Houng-Wei Tsai notices an error regarding a figure, and sent the correct figure to Adam Kahn.
