- President Jane C. Conoley-
  - Congratulated everyone on a successful Cherishing the Children event and saw pics on FB.

- Discussed the 4 pending outdoor classrooms on campus. Next to Design Bldg. is first one. And, outdoor "living room" for students to relax and use. Discussed concerns about enrollment and that the CSUs are down 7% which is a serious problem both in the moment with no state support or tuition dollars so it's a big hit on the budget. Locally, our first-year students, the applicant pool for Fall 2023 is almost 6.7% above last year so that's good but on the other side the transfer pool is down by 6%. Strategies include to try to take more transfer students this Spring and next year some first-year students will be offered a January start rather than a September start. Looming thing nationally "demographic cliff". Grad applications are still in progress and go until the Spring.
- Mentioned recent suicide on campus and our students that assisted and rendered aid.
- False Twitter threats that the campus police alerted police in Oregon and discovered the person had some mental health issues.
- Mentioned and discussed the Student Success Network email report and resources on the basic needs program.
- They are waiting to hear from the Governor if employees will get Friday, 12/23 off work. They will be sending out a notification.
