Pres Conoley:

- Admissions applications increased this year:
 - o First-time/first year increased by 18%
 - Freshman International up 30%
 - Transfer numbers down 30%- majors they want are harder to get into due to impacted course offerings; we don't think these numbers will get better—its' a national trend
 - Issue which threatens our state funding: a lack of persistence among first timers; we
 had been improving, but then in the last couple of years saw decreases; looking at
 ways to support those first timers so they stay longer.
- COZEN O'CONNER Title IX Audit interviews; report specific to LB should come by end of June and I will share the report; overall findings is that Title IX offices are understaffed; Title IX infractions are of concern, but there is also a big issues with bullying behavior—will be doing specific campaigns to address this.
 - Question: with transfers down, are we making it up with first years?
 Answer: Yes, but this is a disruption to the colleges because they must move resources around. Need to look at impacted classes and how to increase access.

Academic Senate Summary

- On summer hiatus for policy work.
- Key initiatives:
 - Official sunset of BeachBoard. Canvas only starting today! Thanks to ATS!
 - Utilizing AI tools in teaching and learning: still very controversial; we will put together some policies and guidelines for using AI and how it will impact academic Integrity; we are still learning about this technology.
 - Title IX and DHR: systemwide interview data collection by Cozen O'Connor law firm; final report will be released soon; some campus specific recommendation to help shape our campus cases evaluations and initiatives to improve.
 - Beach 2030: still working on action zones esp. "Reimaging Faculty" eg. how to reimagine faculty lines & structure.
