Worked in health services for 20 years!

- Teaches meditation for students.
- Leads meditation group in the Kleefeld museum, Thursdays 12:30-1:15 with art!
- Did a meditation exercise at the meeting; Gentle movement and stretches, belly breathing for calming yourself when stressed; breath can impact your mood and activate your "rest & digest" mode instead of "fight or flight;"
- During summer and winter breaks teaches series of 4 sessions about different types of meditation for faculty and staff

Discussion Related to Staff Training on campus:

KS:

- Feels staff was left out of trainings when the pandemic hit & it is good to offer staff incentives to participate in trainings
- Q: Is Discord a tool that we can adopt?
 - Marvin: Teams does similar things—but we can discuss; may be a security issue; good to keep within the MS ecosystem.
 - o SM mentioned that it's more of a student tool.
 - o JL seconded that—and mentioned Teams would be better than Discord

LT:

- ITS offers training for staff; can request group training or one-on-one; talk to Kerri Sorensen.
- Monthly staff Learning and Development newsletter is distributed by DAF has training links.
- ITS tries hard to make sure everything is secure—if you are thinking about using in a third-party app (not supported by university)—be careful about security.

CR:

 We need to reach students "where they are;" probably won't find centralized support for some apps like Discord

JW:

- Suggests training staff about using social media tools, e.g., LINKTREE
- Angela Ratzlaff in Strategic Communications may help with social media

KB:

- Q: Should Staff council BeachBoard be converted to Canvas?
 - Not as effective as Teams

AR:

- When we look at staff, we should not forget our colleagues in BBS and find out what technologies they may use or want to us and be trained on.
- Confusion for staff to know where they can get training because there is no centralized location where staff training opportunities are listed. There is discussion of a professional staff development area within Beach 2030.
