 - o Email coming re: new fund for staff professional development
 - Part of a program of Beach 2030 reimagining staff
 - o Available to all temp and perm / part time and full time
 - New skills & professional growth
 - Differing levels of funds for staff development on campus, so this is intended to level the playing field for more equitable opportunities
 - Online application and requests for up to \$1500 per person
 - Priority given to staff to develop skills they can use in the workplace e.g., DEIA, workplace skills
 - Committee meeting once per month to decide on applications
 - O Discuss with your ASM to see what funds are already available and what opportunities you can do; some depts already have funds avail.
 - o Meant for individuals not groups, so, for example, only 2 people to one conference
 - MyBeach website quick link to submit app
 - o Procedure and requirements you should read esp. for travel restrictions
 - Form: fill out your basic profile; brief description of training e.g. attend a conference etc...;
 will need to upload documents and DOCU SIGN; can download and print
 - Submit at least 45 days prior to opportunity/event since they only meet 1x per month
 - Your dept must pay up front and then we get a reimbursement from DAF after the event
 - Follow up—with a brief statement via Qualtrics 150 words to describe benefits to share with senior level management to justify the value of funds.
 - Can apply only once. Suggest not to use for recurring conference attendance.
 - One award per fiscal year
 - Limited pilot fund depends on how many people apply; first come, first served
 - Meant for training that is not offered on campus
 - o Try to be frugal in your requests so that more people can use it; work with your ASM

Kara P:

- A group is looking at how to fund staff development moving forward
- o This is a pilot—so feedback is important
- Please use this money to supplement what your dept has; most departments have some rollover funds for staff training; each department is funded differently and must prioritize staff salary, operations etc.
- This fund is going to help us see where more funding is needed/who needs training most
