- 3 In accordance with the Chancellor's mandate, the University Mini-Grant and Summer Stipend
- 4 (UMGSS) award committee is designated to serve as the primary advisory body to the Academic
- 5 Senate, the Provost and Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs or designee, and the Office
- 6 of Research and Sponsored Programs, in furthering an atmosphere conducive to research,
- 7 scholarship, and creative activity. The UMGSS is a standing committee of the Faculty Personnel
- 8 Policies Council.
- 9 Among its responsibilities, the University Mini-Grant and Summer Stipend Committee shall:
- 1. Meet to review criteria, processes, and procedures for the review, evaluation, and rating of mini-grant and summer stipend proposals;
- 12 2. Review and rate the proposals for summer stipends and mini-grants;
- 3. Make recommendations to the Provost and Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs
 concerning the awarding of mini-grants and summer stipends;
- 4. Review University policies governing research and creative activities and make
 recommendations to the Faculty Personnel Policies Council;
- 17 5. Work with the Office of Research and Sponsored Programs to generate announcements with deadlines and application forms; and
 - 6. Submit an annual report to the Academic Senate with a copy to the Office of Research and Sponsored Programs.
- Members of the committee are not eligible to apply for either the mini-grant or summer stipend during committee service.
