FRENCH Subject Matter Verification

There are eight domains in World Language: General Linguistics (Domain 1), Linguistics of the Target Language (Domain 2), Literary and Cultural Texts and Traditions (Domain 3), Cultural Analysis and Comparisons (Domain 4), Language and Communication: Oral Expression (Domain 5), Language and Communication: Listening Comprehension (Domain 6), Language and Communication: Reading Comprehension (Domain 7), Language and Communication: Written Comprehension (Domain 8). The CSET groups the domains as follows: Subtest I: General Linguistics and Linguistics of the Target Language (Domains 1 & 2); Subtest II: Literary and Cultural Texts and Traditions and Cultural Analysis and Comparisons (Domain 3 & 4); Subtest III: Language and Communication: Oral Expression, Language and Communication: Listening Comprehension, Language and Communication: Reading Comprehension: Oral Expression, Language and Communication: Written Comprehension, Language and Communication: Reading Comprehension, and Language and Communication: Written Communication (Domains 5, 6, 7, & 8). This table is used to determine domains where candidates meet subject matter via coursework.
