## **Subject Matter Verification**

There are 8 domains in World Language: Japanese: General Linguistics (Domain 1), Linguistics of the Target Language (Domain 2), Literacy and Cultural Texts and Traditions (Domain 3), Cultural Analysis and Comparisons (Domain 4), Language and Communication: Listening Comprehension (Domain 5), Language and Communication: Reading Comprehension (Domain 6), Language and Communication: Oral Expression (Domain 7), and Language and Communication: Written Ex[pression (Domain 8). The CSET groups the domains as follows: Subtest 1: General Linguistics and Linguistics of the Target Language (Domains 1 & 2); Subtest 2: Literacy and Cultural Texts and Traditions and Cultural Analysis and Comparisons (Domains 3& 4); Subtests 3: Language and Communication: Listening Comprehension; Language and Communication: Reading Comprehension; Language and Communication: Oral Expression; and Language and Communication: Written Expression (Domain 5,6,7&8). This table is used to determine domains where candidates meet subject matter via coursework.

\*Students must receive a "C" or better in coursework to receive subject matter credit.
