The CSET groups the domains as follows: Subtest I: General Linguistics and Linguistics of the Target Language (Domains 1 & 2); Subtest II: Literary and Cultural Texts and Traditions and Cultural Analysis and Comparisons (Domain 3 & 4); Subtest III: Language and Communication: Oral Expression, Language and Communication: Listening Comprehension, Language and Communication: Reading Comprehension, and Language and Communication: Written Communication (Domains 5, 6, 7, & 8).
