SPOT - Best Practices for Instructors

Young et al. (2018) (<u>article available</u>) found faculty were an important factor in increasing online response rates.

Here are other suggestions to increase student response rate:

- 1. Provide class time to complete the evaluations (e.g., last 5 minutes of each class) it's anonymous!
- 2. Tell students to click the SPOT Course Evaluation tile on MyCSULB Single Sign-On (SSO).
- 3. Emphasize the importance of student feedback. Share an example of adjustments you have made based on evaluations.
- 4. Remind students to check their email for SPOT completion instructions.
- 5. Post reminders where you post assignments: "Complete SPOT! Click on the SPOT Course Evaluation tile on MyCSULB."
