## CLASS SELECTION INSTRUCTIONS AND AGREEMENT

## SPECIAL ACADEMIC NOTES:

- At CSULB we use the word 'class' to describe each individual subject. In other countries this is sometimes referred to as a 'module' or 'unit'. Each class is made up of 1-4 credits.
- You are required to enroll in a minimum of 12 credits to maintain your visa status.

- Some classes have a required laboratory or activity section. Some classes have a fee associated with the laboratory or activity section that you will need to pay if you are enrolled into the class.
- Sports, Athletics & Recreation (SAR) classes are not available to exchange students. Students wishing to take physical education classes should register in Kinesiology (KIN) courses.
- Some academic areas (music, film, art, design, etc.) require an audition or portfolio review prior to class registration.

## **CLASS SELECTION AND REGISTRATION PROCESS:**

- 1. Make your class selections using the CSULB <u>Schedule of Classes</u>. Class descriptions are available in the <u>University</u> Catalog by subject.
- 2. List eight of your preferred classes in order of priority on your CSULB online application. Not all classes are taught each semester. It is VERY important your class selections are accurate and approved by the exchange advisor at your home university.
- 3. Students will submit class requests and our staff will then initiate the enrollment process with each department on campus. Class requests are NOT guaranteed.
- **4.** Changes to your schedule are discouraged, but will be handled within the first two weeks of the semester. Please be mindful that many classes will be filled by the start of the semester.
