Celebrate the 74th Commencement

In recognition of outstanding graduate student achievements

In recognition of outstanding graduate student achievements, departments may honor graduating Master's degree candidates by special recognition in the annual commencement ceremonies. The number of honors awarded by a department shall be limited to three students or five percent of graduates, whichever is larger.

Departmental Graduate Student Honors are usually reserved for post-baccalaureate students not otherwise recognized by university or college awards. These honors are normally conferred for excellence in and contributions to the discipline, including outstanding seminar papers, artistic exhibitions, special achievements in field work, and service in university committees and functions, as well as participation in scholarly and professional organizations resulting from student research.

Graduates are eligible for departmental honors if they have completed all master's degree requirements and are receiving a diploma dated December 2022, January 2023, May 2023, August 2023, or December 2023.

Deadlines

- Nominations due to department offices: Friday, February 17, 2023.
- Department recommendations for honors due to CNSM College Office: Monday, March 6, 2023.

Criteria

- Nominees must complete all degree requirements and be receiving a diploma dated December 2022, January 2023, May 2023, August 2023, or December 2023.
- Nominees must have graduated (December 2022) or filed for graduation (Deadline: March 1, 2023 for on-time Fall 2023; late filing for Spring/Summer 2023 with \$10 fee).
- Department may have additional requirements.
