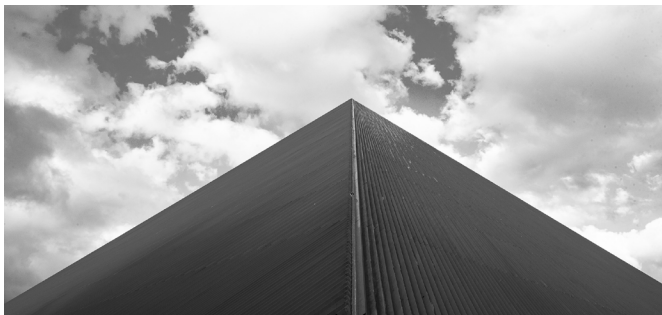

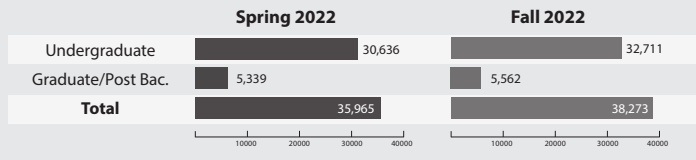

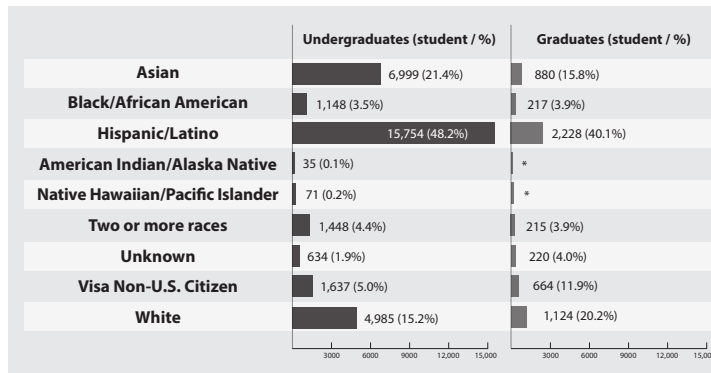
Place of Origin

CSULB DISTINCTIONS

Washington Monthly ranked CSULB 1st in "Best Bang for the Buck" in 2021.

CSULB is the 2nd master's-level university in the nation ranked by *Washington Monthly* in 2021.

CSULB is ranked 3rd in the nation for its impact in driving social mobility in 2021 published by *CollegeNET*.

According to a study in 2022 by Georgetown University's Center on Education and the Workforce, CSULB ranked in the top 10% of universities that provide the most return on investment.

CSULB was designated one of the nation's top "Best in the West" public universities by *The Princeton Review's* "2022 Best Colleges: Region by Region" for its commitment to high-quality education at an affordable cost.

The university ranks 4th nationally in awarding bachelor's degrees to students of color on *Diverse Issues in Higher Education's* annual list of "Top 100 Degree Producers."

CSULB's annual Pow Wow, a Native American social celebration, is the largest Spring event of its kind in Southern California. The event focuses on displaying the university's strong Native American presence.

CSULB's Bob Murphy Access Center provides accessible assistance and services to over 2,000 students each semester.

CSULB's Building Infrastructure Leading to Diversity (BUILD) Program is one of 10 programs in the United States funded by the National Institutes of Health BUILD Initiative.

As part of our commitment to sustainability, CSULB has the largest solar power system on a CSU campus, providing 4.5 megawatts of energy from solar panels.

CSULB's Division I athletic teams surpassed the NCAA's Academic Progress Rate minimum score. The university has exceeded the minimum score for 16 consecutive years.
