## **Frequently Asked Questions**

# • What is the Chicano/Latino Graduation Celebration (CLGC)?

The CLGC is a festive and beautiful event that takes place the weekend before CSULB's Commencement week. The event celebrates students' personal success and academic achievements in the spirit and tradition of the Chicano/Latino culture.

The celebration will take place in-person at the Walter Pyramid on Sunday, May 14<sup>th</sup> at 10am and at 4pm to accommodate our large number of graduates.

# What makes the CLGC so special?

The CLGC is dedicated to familia, comunidad, and cultura. This year's theme is "Por los sueños de mi Pueblo" – "For the dreams of my people". Graduates have an opportunity to publicly thank those who have supported them throughout their educational career by writing a special dedication and walking across the stage. The celebration is also presented bilingually to accommodate both English and Spanish speakers.

#### What will the celebration entail?

The celebration includes brief speeches from honored speakers, cultural performances, and more to honor the Class of 2023.

#### Who can participate?

Any CSULB student completing a degree in Fall 2022, Winter 2023, Spring 2023, Summer 2023, or Fall 2023 may register to participate.

## I am NOT a Chicano/Latino Studies major; may I still participate?

Absolutely. The CLGC is open to **all** CSULB graduating students.

## Is there a cost to participate?

# • How would I purchase additional tickets?

You may purchase up to 3 additional tickets only when registering.

# What if I don't purchase the 3 additional tickets during the registration, can I purchase them later?

You may not purchase the 3 additional tickets after submitting your registration. The 3 additional tickets *must be purchased during your registration submission*. We strongly encourage you to purchase the 3 additional tickets when you register as you will not be able to purchase the tickets after submitting your registration.

#### What if I need more than 7 total tickets?

We cannot guarantee additional tickets but we encourage you to talk to your graduating peers and LSU to identify options.

#### Can I purchase a sash by itself?

No. In order to obtain a sash, you must register to participate at the event.

#### Who can attend?

Friends and family are all welcome to join us in this special event.
