What does Staff Council do?

Staff Council has multiple functions:

- Plans and produces events to benefit staff and provide opportunities to network.
- Creates and promotes opportunities that contribute to staff personal and professional development.
- Facilitates elections and/or assists with appointments to important, prestigious committees such as Provost Search Committee, Student Fee Advisory Committee, Distinguished Alumni Nomination Committee, University Resource Council, International Education Committee, and others.
- Develops fundraising activities that support Staff Council objectives, events, and programs.
- Interacts with the campus President who attends the Staff Council meetings.

Why is it important to have representatives on Staff Council?

Each area represented on Staff Council is unique and diverse. Having representatives will allow your area's ideas, suggestions, needs and expectations to be conveyed to the Council. Representation is based on the number of full and part-time staff in each area: one representative per 25 staff or a portion thereof.

Representatives serve as the liaison between Staff Council and your area. It is crucial that all areas receive important announcements regarding campus events, policy changes, staff development and committee information etc.
