



Request for Financial Aid Disbursement through CSULB for Intrasystem Concurrent or Visitor Enrollment Programs

A CSULB-enrolled undergraduate student participating in the official Intrasystem Concurrent or Visitor Enrollment programs is able to have units from courses taken at a California State University considered as part of their enrollment for CSULB financial aid eligibility purposes. The units from all CSU courses will either be combined with CSULB units or take the place of a semester at CSULB to determine a student's financial aid eligibility.

Financial Aid Consideration: A student requesting financial aid consideration for cross enrollment must have a <u>SAP</u> <u>status</u> that makes them eligible to receive a financial aid disbursement for the cross enrollment term.

Documentation Requirements for CSULB Financial Aid Disbursement

In order to participate in the Intrasystem Concurrent or Visitor Enrollment Programs, and receive your aid at the same disbursement time as CSULB students, the following items must be provided to the CSULB Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships:

- A copy of the <u>Application for Intrasystem Concurrent or Visitor Enrollment Form</u> completed by Enrollment Services
- Confirmation of your Enrollment Status
 - o This can be in the form of an Unofficial Transcript, a copy of your Schedule of Classes through Advisor Center, or by a letter from the Enrollment Services Office through your Host Campus
