Double-Counting of Courses

Beach EDGE students in Communication Studies may double-count 12-MPH electives towards both their BS and MPH degrees.

Students can choose two graduate-level electives and two graduate level concentration courses to double-count for B.S. and MPH. These electives must be completed in residence at CSULB. Transfer courses cannot double-counted.

Graduate core classes (HSC 585, 626, or 696) cannot count for B.S. requirements. These courses also cannot be taken unless in graduate status.
