

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

The MPA degree requires 39 semester units of graduate coursework.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited university or college.
- Cumulative grade point average of 3.0. An applicant not meeting this minimum requirement but with managerial experience may be given special consideration by the Center Admissions Committee.
- One official transcript from all colleges and universities attended, including transcripts showing a B.A. or B.S. degree.
- Public sector experience or a desire to work in the public sector.
- Application deadlines are November 1 for the Spring semester and June 1 for the Fall semester.
- To apply, complete an application for the University at Cal State Apply, and then an application for the program.



MASTER OF PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION

The Master of Public Administration program (MPA), offered by CSULB's Graduate Center for Public Policy and Administration, allows students to either enroll as full-time Master's students or as working professionals earning their Master's degree on a parttime basis without interrupting their careers.

Graduates of the MPA program will be equipped with the theory, practice, and skills necessary to succeed in leadership and management roles in public service and community-based nonprofit organizations.
