- III. Discussion of AB 928 Implications for GE Requirements
  - a. The Academic Senate Executive Board has asked GEGC to provide feedback on proposed options regarding AB 928's GE changes.
    - i. *Option 1*: Align GE requirements with the new legislation for transfer students exclusively. This will likely mean lowering the number of GE units from 48 to 42 by dropping 3 units of LD C and 3 units of LD E and adding a composition element to Critical Thinking.
    - ii. *Option 2*: Standardize the reduction of GE units and curriculum changes for both transfer and first-time, first-year students.
  - b. Eileen Klink and Norbert Schurer, CSULB Senators from the CSU-wide Academic Senate, provided background on the issue.
    - i. There was discussion of several of the complexities involved with different types of student transfers to CSULB.
    - ii. Major questions to consider going forward: should CSULB align with other systems on GE policy? Or should the CSULB campus be permitted to make its own decisions regarding certain aspects of GE policy?
