- Presenting Elbee and the Hidden Disabilities Sunflower
- Merch is available for purchase in the bookstore.
- Go Beach sign at campus entrance-- Elbee is holding the sunflower; has created a lot of buzz-- there is a QR code on it to explain what hidden disabilities are; people are having great conversations and spreading awareness.
- o Sunflower represents hidden disabilities, cognitive, chronic health conditions.
- Started in the UK; Has been popping up around the US-- we are the first 4-yr institution to adopt it within our mascot.
- o A positive symbol that support students and encourages conversations.
- Disability is the largest minority in the US; 1 out of 4 people have a hidden disability; hidden disabilities are not obvious, so it's not something we have learned to deal with. This campaign will help to bring awareness. Disabilities can be temporary or permanent and will affect most of us at some point in our life.
- O How to support?
 - Purchase some merch! Get an Ally pin;
 - Be aware of people who are wearing merch-- treat them like everyone else, but maybe ask them how they would like to be supported.
 - Have conversations -- share your story with others and how you have developed resilience and embrace it as part of who you are.
 - Ask yourself the question, "How can you support hidden disabilities?" Do you know people in your office who may need more intentional support?
- We are at an important point in our history, due to pandemic it highlighted a lot of issues; this goes along with issues related to racial equity and helped inform the movement towards ADA regulations -- so we must work together. We want CSULB to be a place where students will feel supported and welcome for all of their abilities.
