  - Rec 3: Community Building and Collaboration- this is happening in many ways already; may not be necessary to prioritize it. Anna mentioned that by working with other groups for the other priorities, we will deepen our collaboration. Focusing our attention will help us build community with other sectors/ groups on campus. Aurora mentioned that TQSFA does a lot of work and we can support by sharing publicity. We can increase visibility.
  - Rec 4: Enhance Campus Communication- CB mentioned updating campus map about all-gender bathrooms so that LGBTQ students feel safe and have accurate information, since the current map is from 2019 and doesn't reflect the USU closing or the all-gender bathrooms in the Horn Center.
  - Rec 5: Pride Index- Anna shared some background and details about what the Pride Index is and mentioned that this committee

had previously worked on this process. She mentioned it is a complex process that requires a lot of reporting and communication with multiple sectors/ entities on campus. She also indicated that in previous years CSULB was dinged in part because we did not have a student group related to LGBTQ and faith, or an LGBTQ sports group. However we do have non-discrimination policies and the reputation of Long Beach as a queer-friendly place is strong- so the Pride Index may not be accurately reflecting our community.

 Rec 6: Lavender Graduation 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary- discussion around how we can help boost the publicity and support of this event.
