 - 6.1 [Time Certain 2:10 pm] Report from President Andrew Jones- AJ reports on commencement, which will return to the campus this year. The likely venue will be the George Allen field. The pending EEOC matter and the data request for faculty contact information, there is no request for this information at this time. NS thanks the President for bringing commencement back to campus. BT thanks him for meeting with the Chairs this morning.
 - 6.2 Report from Long Beach CFA Co-President Shelly Collins- SC presents on fall assembly which was last week. The BOD voted unanimously to fund a strike fund to be used in the case of actions. Resolution to amend state bylaws has advanced and will be voted in spring. EEOC and federal policy on RTP has asked FA to issue a statement on immigration related policies and practices. Schools must notify

constituents when ICE is on campus. Health insurance recap is not negotiated in CBA, is established in state legislation, so cannot be bargained. At least one plan must be available at no cost to employees. Upcoming events:

7.1 [Presentation on the IPAC summer assessment of written communication](#)

Guest: Sharlene Sayegh, Director of Institutional Assessment- SS presents on this assessment. This was conducted according to the Policy on Institution and Program review. NS asks about using AI for Assessment, SS states they did not use AI in this assessment at all. She is against using AI in assessment in GEEC or any committee. NS asks if improved scoring might have anything to do with ChatGPT, she says yes perhaps. That is a concern, she states.

7.2 [Time Certain 3:40 pm] [Presentation on the reopening of the Child and Family Center](#) (CFC)

Guests: Grace Reynolds-Fisher, Interim Dean, CHHS; Alicia Minor, Director, CFC; Virginia Gray, Chair, Department of Family and Consumer Sciences; Michael Clements, Director of Operations, CHHS- GRF, AM, VG and MC present on the reopening of the CFC. Early spring is the estimate date for the reopening. Previous license was 45 children, now with space for more children, about 100, additional classroom facilities, and student placements and workspaces, and an observation room. They are also now open to student-parents. Student-parents will also get priority, and about 50 spaces guaranteed. Faculty and staff will be next in priority, then the community. Faculty expressed concern over increased cost and priority for students.

8. OLD BUSINESS

8.1 Proposed revision of PS 12-12: Graduation Writing Assessment Requirement (GWAR) in two parts: a policy and a committee charge (AS-1207-23/CEPC) -- SECOND READING- NH tells Senate about the problems with the ad seriatim process in revising this policy. There are four large amendments that need to be dealt with to proceed. We may move to the “committee of the whole” to discuss these to proceed. NS moves to go into the “committee of the whole” for up to 20 minutes to discuss these amendments. Seconded, vote on motion, yes-49 no-5. The 20-minute session begins and will end at 3:21. CB presents the rationale for his amendment. Move to extend the committee of the whole by 20 minutes, no objections; approved by acclamation.
