- 6.1 [Time Certain 2:10 pm] Report from President Andrew Jones AJ presents on the recent EEOC antisemitism complaint against the University. The system is working on a response to a very vague complaint. The EEOC does not typically bring charges against individuals. The complaint is against the CSU. If information is requested for an employee, they will be as transparent as possible while following the law. NS asks if lists of specific faculty will be sent forward when other universities such as CSULA has released a list of names. AJ states that the EEOC was simply asking for contact information to ask for their experience. He also asks about allegations of antisemitism on our campus, is this related? AK asks if individual complaints may have been combined to the system wide complaint. The complaint does mention specific campuses including LB. NS asks about the terms discrimination and antisemitism, and if the protests recently from campus included. LHP asks if any specific documents are included to be turned over in the complaint, such as TPM, or events. AJ says there is a broad request for information from EEOC. BC asks if there has been any discussion on if complaints substantiated, what consequences could exist, too early to determine.
