- [Time Certain 2:10 pm] Report from Provost Karyn Scissum Gunn on behalf of President Andrew Jones- KSG presents on the Division of IT survey: CSU AI survey link: https://aisurvey.calstate.edu VP Yao states that the survey is in progress and encourages participation in this survey and noted demographic section may be skipped. President Jones is meeting with various groups on campus and is quite impressed with the expertise of many faculty members on campus. COE 2.3M Grant, economic development department. Uvalde a documentary, produced by Jesus Ayala from Journalism, follows journalists who cover traumatic events, a viewing on campus will be 10.30.25. CSULB was the winner of an award for outstanding service to underserved populations. Think Beach certificate is introduced. Challenges are faced by US Higher education, ORED reports on research grants, sixteen federal grants were terminated. Other grants may be vulnerable to termination at Minority serving institutions. A Presidential proclamation on H1B visa program was announced. A \$100,000 fee to accompany new H1B visa applications, it is unclear if this will apply to higher education institutions. This does not apply to previously approved visas. Does not prohibit current holders from traveling in and out of the US, does not apply to renewals. Questions about H1B visas should be directed to CIE. CW asks about the possibility of moving the location of commencement, KSG says this is a possibility due to the MLB playoff schedule. NS asks where in the CO the AI survey is coming from. The ASCSU was not involved in this survey, it is a CSUwide imitative to gauge baselines of AI use.
- 6.2 Report from Long Beach CFA Faculty Rights Chair Kelly Janousek-CFA is doing a membership drive since LB is the largest faculty we need to add 200 new members to our ranks. Faculty need these numbers for bargaining power. On campus CFA is tracking which colleges and number of Lecturers being reclassed to Tenure Track positions. This is now allowed in the current contract and FA and CFA created a procedure to make this happen. Events:
