Chinese Specified Electives - Complete TWO of the following courses with grades of "C" or better (6 units total):	
CHIN 380: Languages and Dialects in China (3)	CHIN 102 or Equivalent
CHIN 421: Current Affairs in China (3)	Consent of Instructor
CHIN 451: Chinese Culture and Tradition (3)	Consent of Instructor
CHIN 462: Contrastive Analysis of Chinese and English (3)	Consent of Instructor
