- First-Time, First-Years (Freshmen) who began in Fall 2021 or later: Grade of "C" or better in Ethnic Studies (Category F-ES)

Students pursuing the **Single Subject Credential** must earn a grade of "C" or better in all English Education coursework and earn a minimum overall GPA of 2.67 or a 2.75 GPA in the last 60 semester units to be admitted to the program.
