- A minimum of 21 units of upper division German courses must be taken at CSULB.
- Consult with the major advisor for course selections.
- Studies or an internship in a German-speaking country is recommended.
- Candidates for teaching credential must take GERM 303 and GERM 410 or equivalents.
- Students wishing to pursue the Single Subject Credential in Languages Other Than English (LOTE) in addition to the major must see the LOTE Credential advisor as many classes can count in the major, for GE, and for the credential.
