Subject: 2024-2025 Academic Year Annual Report of the Academic Appeals Committee

Thank you to all who served on the Academic Appeals Committee during the 2024–2025 academic year. Your time, thoughtful deliberation, and dedication to student success played a vital role in supporting our academic standards. The busiest month for appeals was once again July when an AAC sub-committee reviewed 272 disqualification appeals. The month with the fewest appeals was June, with only 13 appeals. Below is a summary of the committee's findings and recommendations for this cycle.

The committee reviewed 900 appeals during the 2024-2025 year which is approximately a 10% increase from the prior year. As in previous years, the two largest appeal categories were Reinstatement appeals (28%) and Disqualification appeals (29%) which combined make up over half of the appeals reviewed. GE substitution (27%) makes up about a quarter of the remaining appeals, which has been a recurring trend over the last few years. The remaining appeals were from the following categories: Withdrawals/Records Problems (5%), Repeat Units (4%), Graduation Requirement (3%), GE Waiver (1%), and Academic Renewal (2%).

Regarding disqualification appeals for 2024-2025, 258 students appealed their disqualification, and 152 were successful and granted an additional term on academic warning. Students who are denied this path are tasked with applying for reinstatement in a future term: the AAC committee approved 121 of the 253 in this category.

An element that should be noted is that of the total 247 GE substitutions, 172 were approved and a large percentage of those were requests for Upper Division courses to meet Lower Division requirements. The AAC has noticed this trend over the last few cycles but is hopeful this trend will taper off as students become more familiar with the GE patterns. Additionally, the AAC recommended that appeals asking to waive less than 1 unit of General Education (GE) credit to complete a GE Area, can be approved by Enrollment Services without sending it to the Academic Appeals Committee for review.

The AAC is pleased with the outcomes of this cycle and believes these decisions and findings reflect our continued commitment to supporting students and their academic success.

Figure 1: Breakdown of Appeals by Category


