## Building Infrastructure Leading to Diversity (**BUILD**)

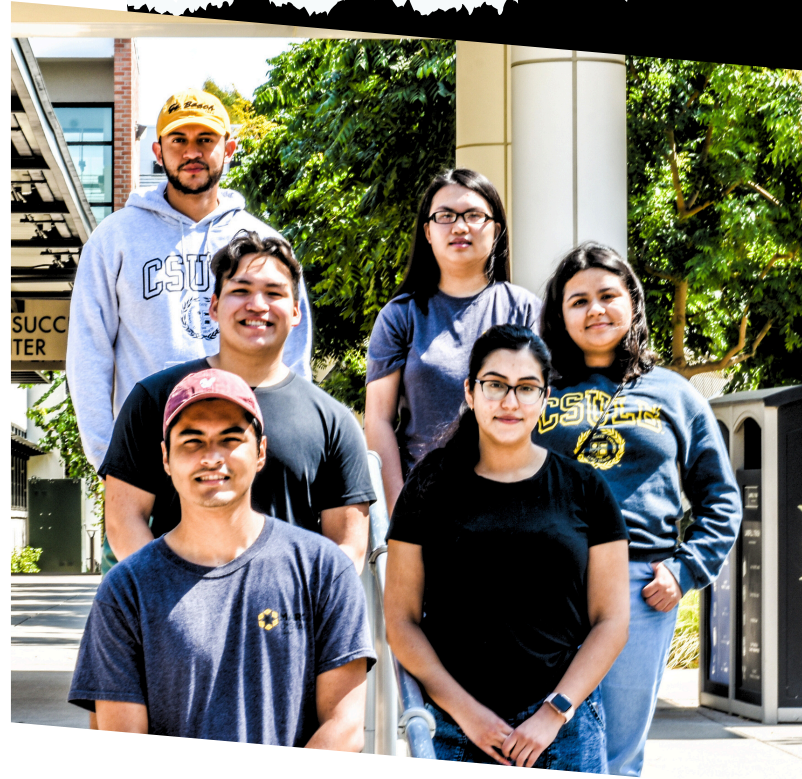

Trainees represent a number of majors including those in the Colleges of Engineering, Health & Human Services, Liberal Arts, and Natural Sciences & Mathematics.
