Since the publication of the Nuventive Program Review Training Manual, Nuventive began a separate project for CSULB to link the degree program reports to department reports and in so doing removed the ability to download self-studies. They have provided a workaround for us as they work on the project.

Step 1: Go to your department page. You'll now see a reports button with no drop down. Click that (image 1) and it will open up a right-hand screen (image 2):

Step 2: Click on the "Department Self Study..." box. When it opens, you will see this:

Step 3: When generated, you'll see your report in "printable" form. Now you can download it. There are a few ways you can do this. If you download it as a **.Zip file, that will ensure both the report itself, and any linked documents, will be downloaded**. The second option is to click the printer icon and use the print to PDF option to save the report as a PDF. Lastly, if you just want to download the report, you can use the icon next to the printer (arrow pointing down) and the report will download as a Word document.
