Why Return to CSULB?

- Make the most of what you started
- Pick up where you left off
- Receive an application fee waiver
- No CalStateApply application needed
- Increase future career opportunities
- Reconnect with a community who cares

- Increase your earning potential
- Expand your skills and knowledge



Eligibility Requirements

- Admitted to CSULB between **Fall 2019** and **Spring 2025**
- Completed at least **one unit** of coursework at CSULB
- Not currently enrolled or on active **Educational Leave**
- Left in **good academic standing**
- Since leaving CSULB, **did not attempt units at another college or university**
- Picking up where you left off in the **same major**

If you do not meet the requirements, you can still speak with an Admissions Counselor to see what's possible!

Steps to Return to CSULB



1. Take the Readmission Pathway Quiz
2. Apply for financial aid
3. If admitted, register for classes and pay the fees
4. Meet with an Admissions Counselor if you have questions

Step 1: Take the Readmission Pathway Quiz

Your response helps the Office of Admissions determine where you left off on your academic journey at CSULB and what next steps are.

Once you've completed the quiz, an acknowledgement letter will be sent to you by email.

Step 2: Apply for Financial Aid

Deadline: Applications are typically available in the Fall semester each year, with a priority deadline the following Spring.

Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Application	California Dream Act (CADAA) Application
You (the student) have a valid Social Security Number	You (the student) do not meet criteria to file a FAFSA
You (the student) are a U.S. Citizen; Permanent Resident; or eligible non-citizen	You (the student) meet the conditions of California AB540 status
Eligible to receive funding from federal, state, and institutional aid programs	Eligible to receive funding from CA State and CA institutional aid programs

FAFSA Filers: Use **CSULB School Code 001139** on your application

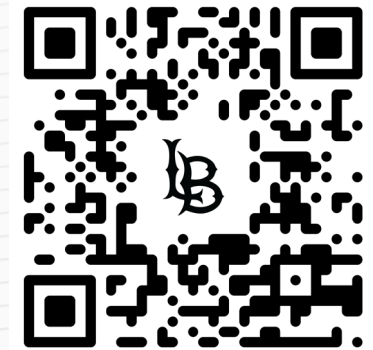
