We are seeking funding for the first step in the development of The Hub — an 8-10 month planning process that brings together key partners in the basic needs field to establish the scope, content, processes, and sustainability plan for The Hub.

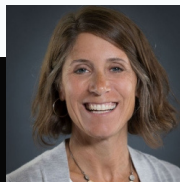
