## • Neil Hultgren, Academic Senate Chair

- Senate has 3 more meetings before end of semester; typically weekly meetings; final meeting May 1 and will kick off Senate seats for the next academic yea; will elect new members and fill committees (more info on staff vacancies on Senate committees below in the "Nominating" report if you are interested in joining).
- Passed the "Culminating Activities" policies in March; sent to Pres., waiting for signature; Masters' degrees policies will be updated and it is a good development
- Senate is currently working on Emeritus policy for retired faculty and eligibility for the title
- Back to work on GWAR policies—CSU Chancellor's office just recently changed some policies on this, so now we have to revise ours to fit the CSU system policy
- Staff Council (Colleen and Ann) presented a resolution to Senate about the creation of a system-wide Staff Council body; will move to a reading on the floor of the next Senate meeting—it had positive approval so far and hopefully will be finally approved.
  - Staff Council will share this resolution with our members when it is finalized.
     The purpose of this resolution is to have staff representation on the CSU Board of Trustees meetings. There is currently no role for staff rep at the meetings.
