The Challenge

The challenge is that the cities we live in have high rent costs and a lack of housing. It's affecting the people and families in Los Angeles, especially those who lost homes due to the fires and those who come from low-income backgrounds, increasing the risk of homelessness and limiting economic diversity. The causes of higher living costs are inflation, a limited supply of rental units, and increased construction costs.
